To daughter Anne Willoughby £100 when 21 and £50 out of legacy given me by my father Christopher Willoughby gent deceased. Residuary Legatee: my son William Willoughby when 21. My mother to have my children for education etc. Executors: Mr. Richard Jennett, Mr. William Seyliard, Witnesses: Tho. Seyliard, James Seyliard, Jo. Jsyliard, Francis Seyliard. Debts owing my testator: To Mr. W. Seyliard £30. Sister Bridgett Willoughby £40, [] Brother Alexander Randall £20, Henry Stanford £20. Executors of Margaret Carpenter deceased £10. (Russell, 22)
